Festival Rules

- 1. CCTV that records sound and audio will be in operation throughout the festival site.
- 2. Owners are responsible for the behaviour of their guests. This includes owners who are not on the park and have sublet their caravan/chalet. Any serious behaviour breaches by guests could also result in the owner being asked to remove their caravan/chalet from the park.
- <u>3.</u> Wristbands must be always worn and visible. If you are seen without a wristband, you may be asked to leave the event.
- <u>4.</u> We reserve the right to conduct security searches from time to time, and to refuse admission to you, or eject you from the event should you refuse to comply with security searches. No refunds will be given if you are refused entry or ejected due to your own behaviour.
- 5. Bicycles, scooters, roller skates and other similar items are not permitted at the festival.
- 6. Well behaved dogs are permitted into the festival and must be always kept on a short lead. Extendable leads are not permitted. If a dog is a nuisance, the owner will be asked to remove it from the festival.
- 7. You are not permitted to bring your own food and beverages to the event.
- 8. We are operating the 'Challenge 25' policy at the bars, so any person who appears to look younger than 25 may be asked for ID. If they cannot provide ID, the bar will refuse to sell them alcohol.
- <u>9.</u> All drinks served at the festival will be served in a plastic vessel. This includes drinks purchased from and consumed inside the Showboat Club.
- 10. We want all our guests to have a great time at Clarach Fest, and our team is there to help should you need any assistance. Bearing this in mind, we operate a zero-tolerance policy against any forms of abuse or aggression against our team or other festival-goers. Any attendees who use threatening or offensive, verbal or physical behaviour will be removed immediately from the festival.
